At q19, respondent asked if we were sponsored by a tobacco company. I repeated that we were sponsored by researchers at Rutgers university. (she is a smoker.) At q20 respondent asked if we were anti-smoking. I explained that I am trying to be unbiased because I didn't want to bias her answers, and then I read to her from the answers to questions from respondents, that the "results will be used by scientists who are studying smoking and non-smoking behaviors."

Cigarettes should not be allowed to be advertised anywhere not in magazines. Also the woman gave me a phone number of someone she wanted us to interview who is also strongly against smoking and works on anti-smoking campaigns (415) 586-3711

Clarification on q32: they should not be allowed to advertise anywhere

Difficult r, because he sd. He couldn't answer many questions, because of the way they were worded. E.g. He had no idea what the average smoker did, so he couldn't compare himself. I tried to tell him that it is his opinion of the average, etc. But he couldn't say. He was sincere, not like he was just making it difficult for me

Everyone always smokes around me so I think I have as high a risk as they do

For q14_1 respondent said that emphysema is 1 "more a nagging problem", but for q14_2 she said that emphysema is 4 "not curable". On q25 respondent answered 2 "no" she didn't think taxes on cigarettes should be raised, and she offered that she didn't believe it was spent on health care costs. (regarding q44_2) repeating an answer, respondent said she had a stroke and sometimes cannot say words right

For q43 respondent mentioned health problems and shortness of breath as reasons she wished she never started smoking, yet on q44_2 respondent answered a "no" she has not had any health problems from her smoking for twenty years. (by the way, her voice sounded a bit rough.)

For q44_1 respondent answered "no" then she told me that her "grandfather has been smoking since he was twelve, and he's eighty-three now, and he's had a heart attack, and triple bypass surgery, and a stroke."

For q49 respondent said she got her GED, but there was no answer category for that. The last grade she completed was the ninth grade. For q44_2 respondent offered that she has had bronchitis and emphysema from smoking. She also has heart disease but she thinks that was hereditary

For race question, r said "black and Asian" so I repeated all the categories, & she said "black I guess"

For the questions about do you tend to agree or disagree with statements about smoking, r sd. He had a hard time answering them, because they were too vague (basically) because they mention smoking but not how long someone smokes for, etc. He was different because he only smoked occasionally at parties

He mentioned both his parents died of emphysema

He really hoped this would help, because there are so many people out there that shouldn't be smoking. His dad smokes

No advertising in any magazines

Noticed that her British friends smoke alot and are very moody - mod and smoking seemed to have a correlation to her. Regarding the increasing law penalties on providing minors with cigarettes - - .admission or the raising of fines is admitted (defeat) and keeping the same law and enforcing it better is optimal

On q 25 "I think the tax should be raised to prevent people from smoking not to cover the cost of treatment."

- On q2 respondent answered 4 "smoking" but he already knew the survey was about smoking, after asking for more information about "health issues". He agreed to do the interview because he's in the process of quitting (q40). On q20 respondent said it would be 3 "very hard and I might not be able to do it" indicating his present attempt to quit. He answered 1 "yes" on q22 he craves them, and explained later he is using nicotine gum. On q32 he said an ad change would be a double-standard. On q34 he smoked a pack and a half daily before quitting
- On q25 respondent answered 2 "no" she wouldn't support an increase in cigarette taxes to cover healthcare costs and she volunteered that her reason was that "it's not being spent on that, anyway." On q27 she answered 5 "all" of the tobacco settlement money should be spent by states to help reduce smoking. Before answering she asked me "and we're only talking about the settlement money from tobacco companies, right?" Maybe distinguishing from cigarette tax q25
- On $\widetilde{q}25$ respondent said "no" then offered "I don't think it would help." He may have thought we meant raising taxes as a deterrent, rather than to fund healthcare. On q39 respondent said "no" he doesn't consider himself addicted although on q37 he said he tried quitting three times. Also in the first open-end he describes that he doesn't consider himself a smoker, as he currently only smokes on weekends occasionally. On q43 respondent wishes he never started, due to health problems, yet on q44_2 he answers "no" health problems
- On q29 respondent answered "I don't know, because I haven't seen Canada's warning labels". On q43 respondent had difficulty giving a reason why he wouldn't start smoking if he had it to do over again. The only reason he gave, after probing, was the cost. Yet on q44_2 respondent said he has had health problems from smoking (didn't say what)
- On q32 respondent first said she didn't think tobacco companies should advertise to any teens then she changed her answer to 2, magazines that "almost no teens" read. On q32-1 and 32-1 respondent said that she couldn't answer them; both were 7 "refused" because she didn't think it would make any difference whether merchants were penalized for selling to minors or if we raised the selling age to twenty one; she said if teens want to get cigarettes then they will find a way to get them, especially if they are addicted to them
- On q43 respondent describes health problems such as coughing and shortness of breath. However, on q44_2 respondent answered 2 "no" he did not have any health problems from his smoking
- On q44_2 respondent said "it just makes me sicker, you know, because it lowers your immune system, I just get the flu more and stuff." She is a seventeen year old female who has smoked regularly since she was fifteen
- On q48 respondent said that he is currently completing his GED. Respondent offered that it is difficult for him to quit because his friends and girlfriend smoke, and their smoking "bugs" him while he is trying to quit, so he ends up smoking with them

On race she said she was "a little of this and a little of that"

- Q 32: they shouldn't advertise smoking anywhere. It's America and a free country so I think smoking is allowed because it is free choice but the choice is killing us. If people stop smoking it will make me proud
- Q14-15 and others: respondent is a seventy-six year old female who currently smokes and has emphysema from smoking. Her husband died of lung cancer, he lived sixteen months after he was diagnosed. She said the doctor said he got it from smoking but she says she doesn't know that. Her answers reflect her condition
- Q29 regarding Canada's labels and us warning labels, respondent is from Germany, giving her a different point of view. Respondent answered q44_2 with "no, I wouldn't say so, nothing medical, just shortness of breath."

Q5-05 respondent currently has the flu

Question 25: woman says she would support this tax only if we created a health care program like the ones they have in Canada or Europe. She also says she has been a drug addict in the past and has emphysema and wants to quit but can't because she doesn't want the weight gain

Question 27 r said he is against the lawsuits of tobacco co

R felt that putting pictures on packs(Canada labels) would not do any good. She said if people can read, they understand the dangers of smoking

R felt that the advertising of smoking should not be allowed in magazines at all

R from south America

R had a comment to make. Her comment: seeing that I am addicted to cigarettes, I find it ironic having lived in other countries that the us will give tax breaks to addicts and yet the entire health system of this country is shocking. There are so many young people who do not have health insurance. My greatest bane is the health system of the

- united states. I used to live in Canada and they have a decent health system. We will probably never have a decent health system or good race relations
- R had comment on q. 8f. Said his smoking was influenced by his drinking. And if his family had more influence he would smoke less
- R had comment on question #7c: there are exceptions to the general rule that the longer you smoke the harder it is to quit. My grandpa smoked for 50 years then quit cold turkey
- R had comments on question 26: charge 2 dollars a pack after I quit. Question 32: no advertising anywhere
- R had comments. On #25: "the tax burden should fall on the tobacco companies. They should pay a percentage of their profits to health costs. The smoker should not have to pay. And on ques.#25: no advertising allowed anywhere except where the cigarettes are sold
- R has emphysema. R. Had comment on question 27: "the tobacco co. Didn't make anybody smoke."
- R is a dental hygienist
- R is a police officer
- R is autistic, so her mother asked her the questions, r typed the answers on a computer, and her mother told me her answers
- R opposes using tobacco settlement money for prevention because programs like the dare program just made he want to smoke more; does not believe there should be any restrictions on magazine advertising because she does not believe teens are influenced by ads
- R said she had tried everything to quit smoking from hypnosis to zyban and nothing works for her
- R said: question #29: "heck no" question" #38 not a regular smoker just smokes a little with friends. Question #?: Referring to the price of cigarettes. "raise it to the sky but lower the price of nicorette patches
- R sd he had smoked in the past, but considered himself a nonsmoker
- R sd her family has had many deaths from smoking illnesses
- R sd she quit once for 18 years
- R sd. "thank you for your time"
- R sd. At the school down the block, youngsters not even 12 are smoking cigarettes; also that in the province of Quebec, he sd. You can't even buy cigarettes. [that's hard to believe]
- R sd. 'Don't know' for a few of the questions comparing himself to the average smoker. He commented that he doesn't know what the average smoker does
- R sd. She had emphysema, and her husband had died of lung cancer
- R smokes cigars and has heart disease in the family; also parents both smoked -- mother died of breast cancer & father of heart disease but he doesn't know what role smoking played in either. Father also had fatty diet
- R wanted to know what magazine survey will be published in, so I gave him OSRL web address R. Had a comment. She said, "I have been here a long time on this earth. I've seen many people who get lung cancer who didn't smoke, as well as well as those who did. It's a terrible, painful thing to die from smoking should be banned. My mother smoked while she was pregnant and while I was an infant. I hope we don't get it. All my children have tried it and quit."
- R. Had comment on question 32: they should not advertise anywhere
- R. Had comment on question 27: "I disagree with the lawsuits. Nobody made us smoke. No one twisted their arm to smoke
- R. Had comment on question 27: 'with the surgeon generals warning on the cigarette packages, its common sense that smoking is bad for you and you can't blame the companies
- R. Had comment on question 32: "they should be no advertising anywhere because it doesn't really affect us"
 R. Had comments on 2 questions: #17: r. Said, "I don't believe in the nicotine addiction, I believe in the hand-mouth addiction." And on #27: r. Said "I don't believe there should be any lawsuits - None of the money should be spent on that.'
- R. Had comments: question 5: depends on age of person exposed to 2nd hand smoke. My brother and I were exposed as babies and he has asthma and I have bronchitis. I think that when you expose an adult to 2nd hand smoke the risks are not as bad. Question 41: I already quit
- R. Wanted to share this comment with researchers. I think that smoking is a good thing. It is good because it helps population control. I think its bad for us but its good because of the increases in the long lives we live. I think its good to try to help kids to stop smoking but I don't think smoking should be illegal. (the boy said his grandma just died of emphysema. And he has had pneumonia many times
- Respondent Had difficulty understanding and speaking clear English
- Respondent did not volunteer it for q40_1 (which she answered 1 not sure she wants to quit), but earlier in the interview she said she doesn't consider herself to be a smoker and also said that she had previously quit. She contradicted herself somewhat by saying in the open end at the start of the interview that she'd recently tried it and stopped (she thought it was "disgusting"), but she may have said that because her mother may have still been nearby (even if she meant what she said)
- Respondent had to stop for a coughing spell as he is a smoker and also has an illness right now
- Respondent has emphysema
- Respondent has heart trouble and emphysema
- Respondent is currently trying to quit smoking, which is reflected in his answers to q20 (2) and q22 (1). On q34 respondent first said (3) that he smoked six to ten cigarettes a day in the past month, but then clarified that he is

currently trying to quit (9), and that he initiated that during the past month. On q40_1 respondent said he does want to quit (3) and then added that he is currently attempting to quit (4)

Respondent refused to answer q32, stating that he didn't think the tobacco companies need to advertise at all.

Respondent started smoking at age five. Yet he said that he did think he would have the strong cravings when he started. He said he never wants to quit and never tried. He doesn't think smoking affects his health. Respondent said the grades in school in his country only go to the sixth grade

Respondent said she is mixed white and native American. Respondent first said she doesn't consider herself to be a smoker because she only tried them in the last thirty days and later her answers began to reveal that she actually smokes more regularly, has cravings, in fact for q34 she answered that she smoked about a pack a day in the past month and for q39 she admitted that she is addicted to cigarettes

Respondent said that 'no' he doesn't consider himself to be a smoker in q3a, but after answering many questions he changed his answer to 'yes' for q39

Respondent said: "my mother died five years ago with a very serious case of emphysema. My brother smokes tobacco and he lived with her. I also was exposed and now I have it, the beginnings of it. I have a type of bronchitis and it's terrible, this morning I have a cold and I am suffering a lot because I can't breathe very well, it's very hard for me to breathe. I suffocate a little bit because my lungs are not in very good shape. Do you have any medicine to get rid of this cold? I have had it for a month and can't get rid of it

Respondent wanted to change her answer to q2 to "smoking" after we began asking questions about smoking, but I did not back up and do it because I figured she was influenced by those questions that followed q2. On q48 respondent said she is currently both a senior in high school and a freshman at the community college

R's grandfathers both died of lung cancer

She says smoking sucks (she is exposed to 2nd hand smoke)

She sd. Smoking is a very bad topic for me and my family; she initially refused to do survey, because she had lost her husband and brothers to smoking related illnesses

Should not allow advertising in any magazine

Sixteen year old male respondent said he has tried smoking cigars a couple of times but not cigarettes

Teen male respondent says his race is Inuit

The boy's grandmother wanted to listen in on this call. I do not know if she did or not

The female respondent said she was a junior in college

The man said he was Indian, Irish and English

The r said I'm from India

The r was not pleased with the wording of a lot of the questions. He took issue with about 60 % of them

The r. Asked at the end of the survey, can I change my first answer to smoking?

They should not advertise at all. I am not influenced by cigarette ads

They should not advertise at all. My husband died of lung cancer. He didn't smoke

They should not be allowed to advertise at all

They should not be allowed to advertise at all. Cigarette ads do not affect me

This older woman restated a number of time that the only thing she regretted about smoking cigarettes was the current demonization of smokers by society

This respondent had a very strong accent and did not seem to understand the questions but gave answers anyway. She also referred to herself as a former smoker various times

When asked for the first open-ended question, why he doesn't consider himself a smoker respondent answered that he smokes cigars (cigarillos?) But he previously indicated that he also smokes cigarettes sometimes. For q50 respondent said "that's a hard one" and when I asked why he said "because I'm two of them" (races) then when I offered to make a note about both races he answered "I guess I'm black" and didn't say what other race he is
