Academic Costume

The history of academic dress goes back several centuries, to the chill universities where cap and gown and hood were needed for covering and warmth. Subsequently this has become a ceremonial costume, with certain standardized features. For example, sleeves in the bachelor's gown are pointed, in the master's gown are oblong, in the doctor's gown are bell-shaped. Only the doctor's gown has velvet facing. The hood is lined with the official colors of the degree-conferring institution; for the University of Oregon these are lemon yellow and green. The outside trimming of the hood and the color of the tassel signify the subject in which the degree is conferred, as follows:
