The Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) received the attached notice of adoption. A copy of the adopted plan amendment is available for review at the DLCD office in Salem and the local government office.

Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: August 15, 2008

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review 45 days prior to adoption. Pursuant to ORS 197.830 (2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

*NOTE: THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE ABOVE DATE SPECIFIED.

ORDINANCE NO. 4897

An Ordinance amending the comprehensive plan map from Industrial to Residential and rezoning certain property from an M-2 (General Industrial) zone to an R-4 (Multi-Family Residential) zone on a 6,995 square foot parcel of land.

RECITALS

The Planning Commission received an application (CPA 1-08/ZC 1-08) from Ramon Olmedo, dated April 16, 2008, for an amendment to the comprehensive plan map and a zone change from an M-2 (General Industrial) zone to an R-4 (Multi-Family Residential) zone on a 6,995 square foot parcel of land. The property is more specifically described as Tax Lot 8300. Section 21BA, T. 4 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

A public hearing was held on June 19, 2008, at 6:30 p.m. before the McMinnville Planning Commission after due notice had been given in the local newspaper on June 10, 2008, and written notice had been mailed to property owners within 300 feet of the affected property; and

At said public hearing, testimony was received, the application materials and a staff report were presented; and

The Planning Commission, being fully informed about said request, found that said changes conformed to the plan amendment and zone change review criteria listed in Chapter 17,72.035 of Ordinance No. 3380 based on the material submitted by the applicant and findings of fact and the conclusionary findings for approval contained in the staff report, all of which are on file in the Planning Department, and that the plan amendment and zone change are consistent with the Comprehensive Plan; and

The Planning Commission approved said plan amendment and zone change and has recommended said changes to the Council; and now, therefore,

THE CITY OF McMINNVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. That the Council adopts the findings and conclusions of the Planning Commission, staff report on file in the Planning Department, and the application filed by Ramon Olmedo.
- Section 2. That the comprehensive plan map designation for the property described in Exhibit "A", is hereby amended from Industrial to Residential.
- Section 3. That the property described in Exhibit "A", is hereby rezoned from a M-2 (General Industrial) zone to an R-4 (Multi-Family Residential) zone.
