NOTICE OF ADOPTED AMENDMENT

The Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) received the attached notice of adoption. A copy of the adopted plan amendment is available for review at the DLCD office in Salem and the local government office.

Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: November 18, 2008

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review 45 days prior to adoption. Pursuant to ORS 197.830 (2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

*<u>NOTE:</u> THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE ABOVE DATE SPECIFIED.

- 5. The deadline to appeal will not be extended if you submit this notice of adoption within five working days of the final decision. Appeals to LUBA may be filed within TWENTY-ONE (21) days of the date, the "Notice of Adoption" is sent to DLCD.
- 6. In addition to sending the "Notice of Adoption" to DLCD, you must notify persons who participated in the local hearing and requested notice of the final decision.

AN ORDINANCE FOR A POST ACKNOWLDGEMENT PLAN AMENDMENT TO INCLUDE A PORTION OF TAX LOT 2400 MAP 16S47 OF THE MALHEUR COUNTY ASSESSOR'S OFFICE AS A SIGNIFIGANT AGGREGATE SITE TO MALHEUR COUNTY'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, GOAL 5, MINERAL AND AGGREGATE INVENTORY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Malheur County Court held duly published hearings on October 1, 2008 and October 15, 2008 for an area to be added to the Malheur County Comprehensive Plan Goal Five, Mineral and Aggregate Resources Inventory, a significant site; and

WHEREAS, the proposed area is approximately 13 acres of tax lot 2400 on Map 16S47 maintained by the Malheur County Assessor's Office located in Section 6, T.16 S., R47 E., W.M. with reference number 6205 (site). The legal description of the aggregate site is set forth in Exhibit 1, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the request to add the site to the Comprehensive Plan Goal 5 Mineral and Aggregate Inventory is made by Delos Lee, Applicant and Landowner; and

WHEAREAS, the quantity of aggregate for the site is 30,000 tons (approximately 18,000 cubic yards); and

WHEREAS, the soils of the site are not mapped on the NRSC inventory. Private testing indicates the soils as characterized by sandy silt with traces of 2 inch minus subrounded cobbles underlain by poorly graded gravels with fine to medium-grained sand with occasional 3 inch minus subrounded gravel; and

WHEREAS, the Malheur County Planning Commission approved the site and recommended that the Malheur County Court add the site to the Comprehensive Plan Goal 5, Mineral and Aggregate Inventory

NOW THEREFORE, THE MALHEUR COUNTY COURT, STATE OF OREGON, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: ADDITION OF SITE TO MALHEUR COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN GOAL FIVE MINERAL AND AGGREGATE RESOURCES INVENTORY

13 acres of tax lot 2400 on Map 16S47 maintained by the Malheur County Assessor's Office in Section 6 with a reference number of 6205 shall be included on the Malheur County Comprehensive Plan Goal Five Mineral and Aggregate Resources Inventory as a significant site. The site acres are more particularly described on Exhibit 1 attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2: EMERGENCY. An additional aggregate resource site is immediately necessary for the safety, maintenance and construction of roads, bypasses and interchanges in Malheur County. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect on the day of its adoption.
