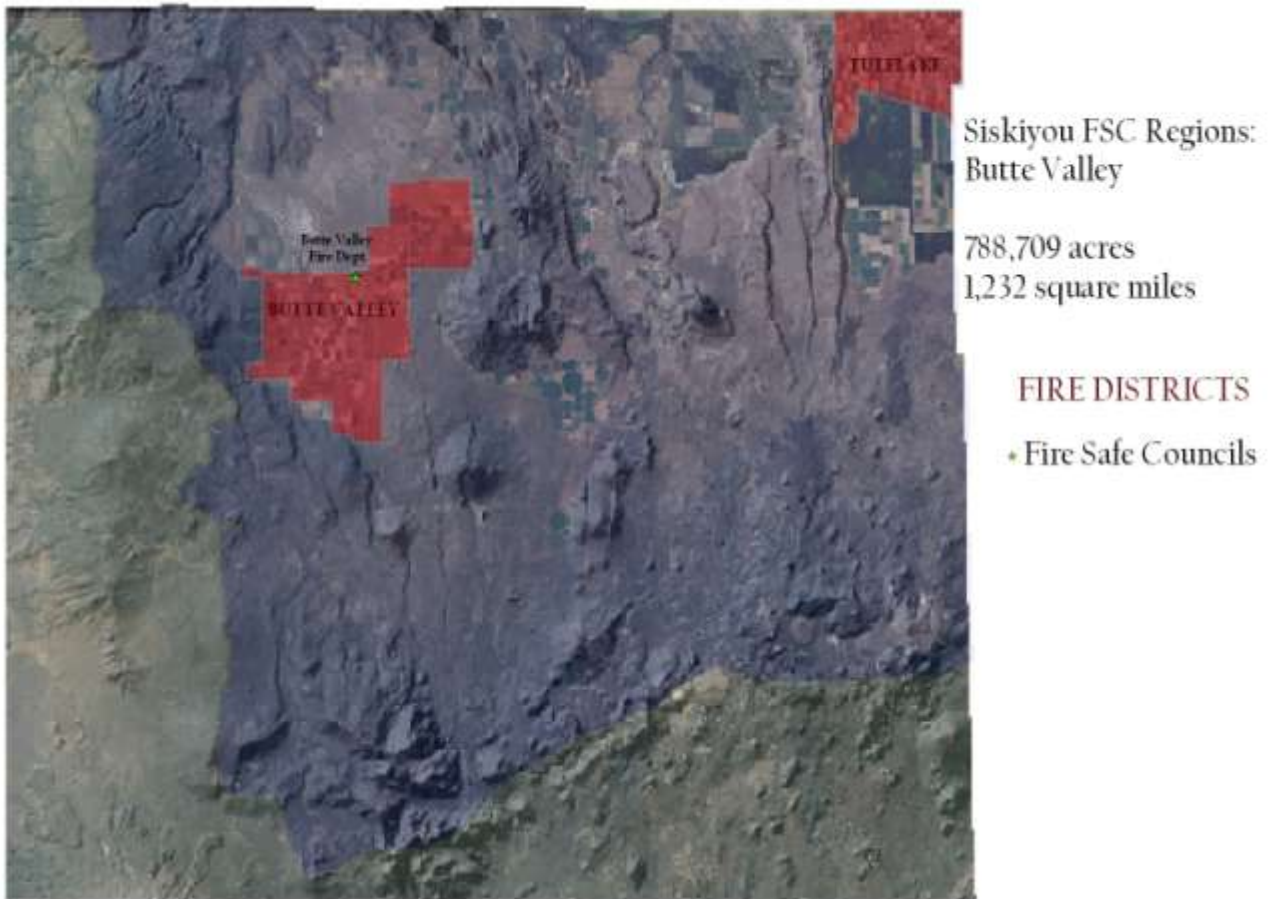

# Butte Region Emergency Access Routes

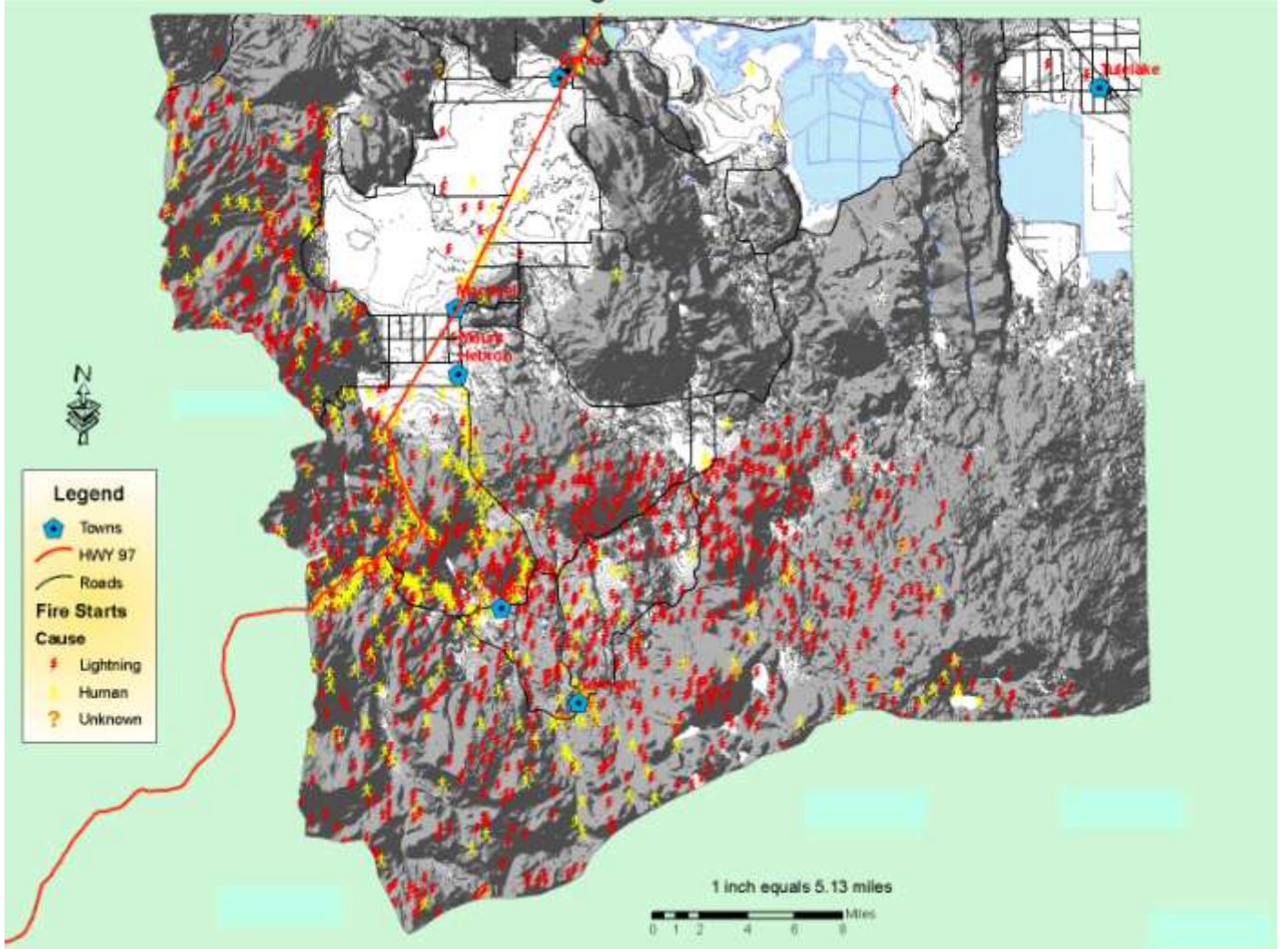

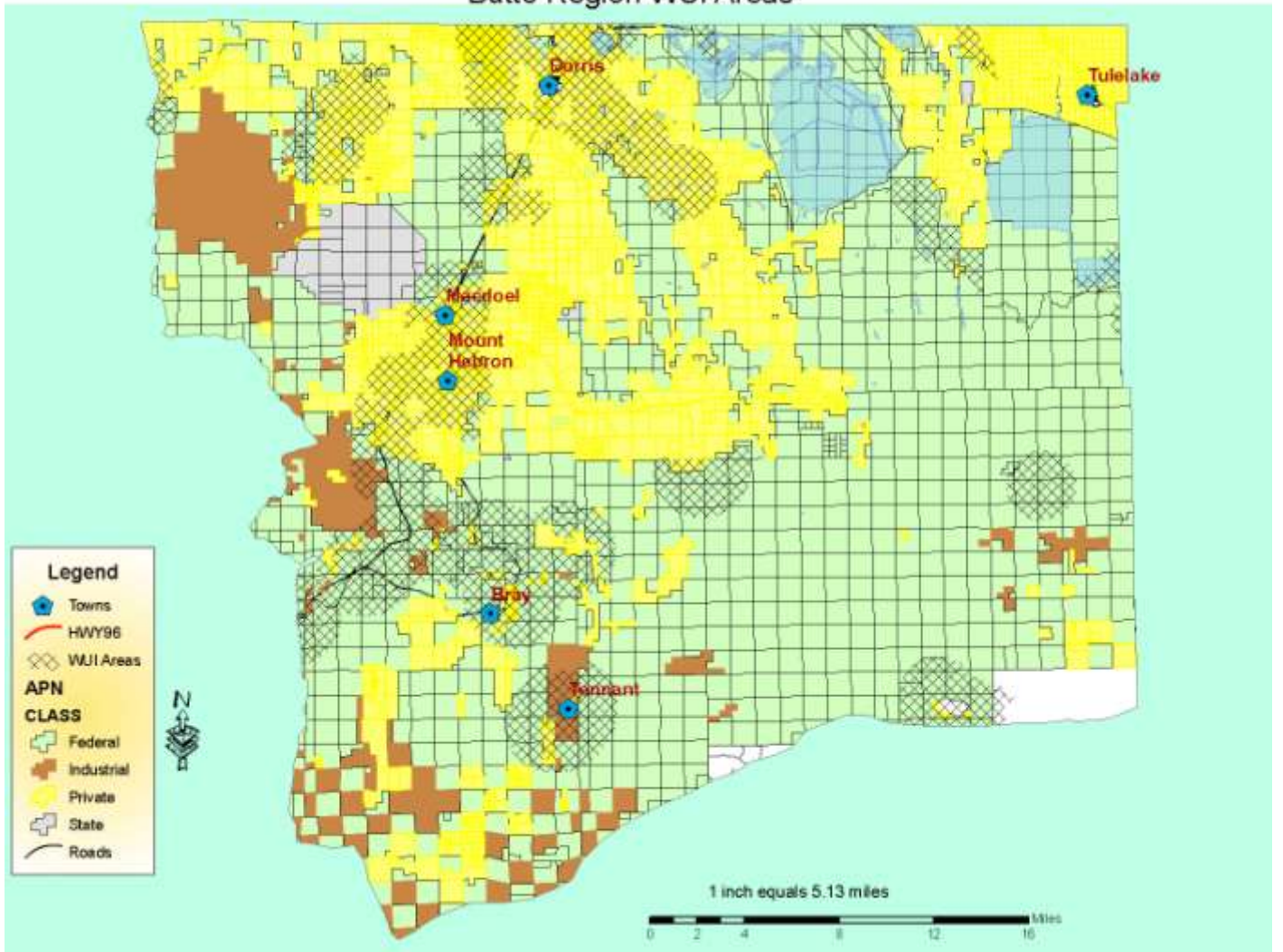
