


## Scholars' Bank



### Basic keyword search

Use the yellow search box on the upper left of the screen to search all communities and collections in Scholars' Bank at once.

To search only within one community or collection, follow the links until you get to the homepage for the community or collection and then use the gray search box in the center of the screen.

### Search hints

Boolean operators: AND, OR, NOT

**In Scholars' Bank, these operators must be CAPITALIZED.** If they aren't, they are ignored. Use parentheses to group search terms into sets:

*cats AND dogs*

*cats OR dogs*

*cats NOT dogs*

*(cats OR dogs) AND (training OR discipline)*

Variant spellings: Search all possible spellings, abbreviations and word divisions.  
*archeology archaeology* retrieves items using either spelling

Truncation: \* <asterisk>  
*educat\** retrieves education, educator, etc.

Phrases: "" <quotation marks>  
*"civil war"* retrieves only records with entire phrase
