The main issues

- Placement of serial title in IR hierarchy
- Collection/community names
- Organization of serial issues
- Organization of issue content
- Construction of item titles

Caveats

- Issues & choices tied to IR software
- Impacted by earlier decisions about overall IR organization, content & workflow
- Not a decision flowchart many things must be considered at the same time
- There is no one correct answer!

Questions to think about

- What type of content is it?
- How will the content be used?
- Is order important?
- Are relationships between titles important?

More questions to think about

- How much control can the IR manager have?
- How much control does the IR manager want to have?
- How do each of these questions relate to each of the main issues listed on Slide 2?
- Do you (does your institution) really care?


